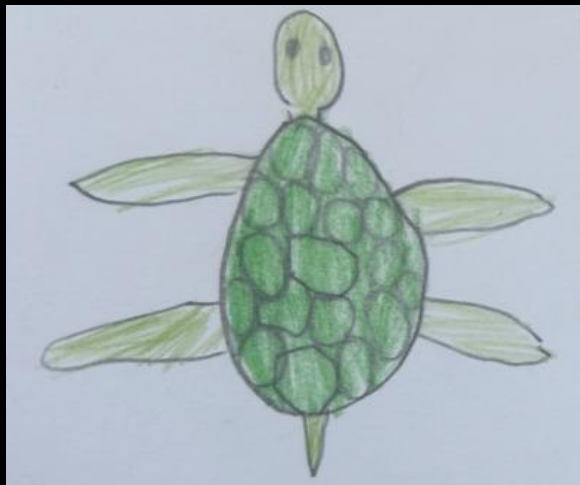

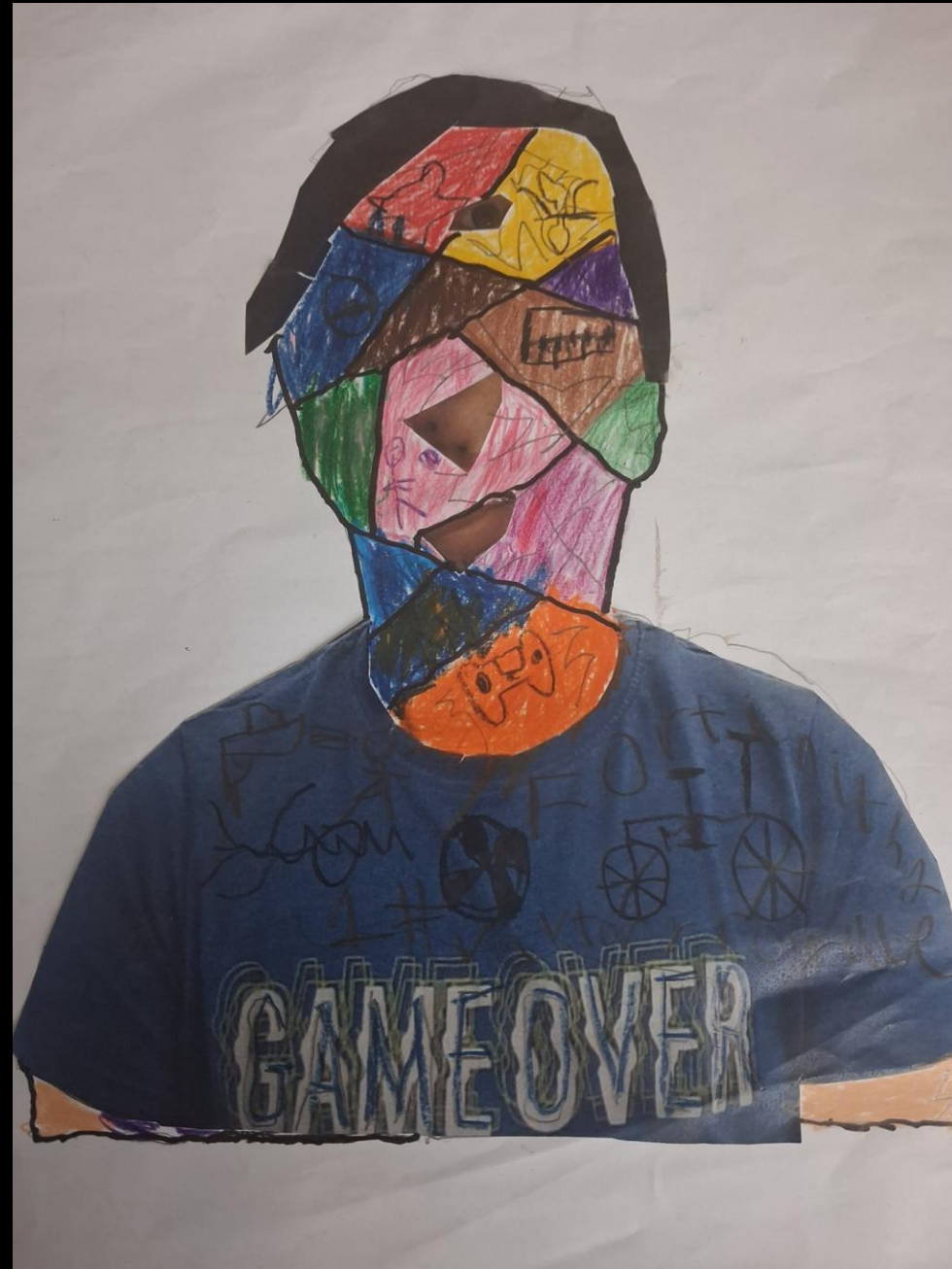
Discombobulated by the damage they gazed at the
