OPAL playtimes

We have lots of new, exciting and fun things to do at lunchtime. Children may get wet, muddy or sandy!

Children are expected to be outside in almost all weathers. They **must have waterproof clothing** in school to allow this - this could be their forest school clothing.

We only have inside play during very extreme weather!

Please make sure that your child has a **fully waterproof coat and shoes** in school at all times (or has worn them to school on rainy days!)



Forest School / Nature Zone

Forest school in a nutshell...

- Is an ethos and not a place.
- Is child-centred.
- Encourages risk taking such as tool use and climbing.
- Is risk assessed to ensure that it is safe enough.
- Encourages co-operation, team building and helps build a sense of community.
- Aims to help child build a respectful relationship with the natural world.

What your child needs for Forest School:

All children need strong waterproof footwear such as wellies or walking boots.

Encourage your child to wear two pairs of socks and a base layer to trap the heat, plus warm clothing under their waterproofs.



If you are buying from scratch, this type of gear is the best suited for Forest school rather than an “all in one”.
