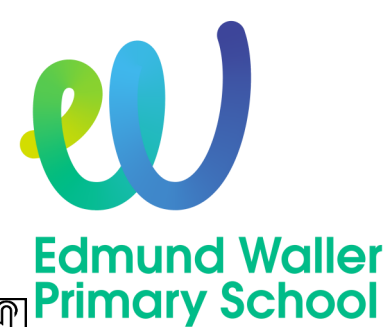

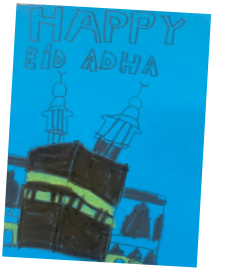

Edmund Waller School Vision

Over the past few weeks we have been exploring the themes that are woven across our curriculum. We have highlighted that the curriculum aims to actively engage learners in the more challenging aspects of these themes, particularly this country's role in Empire or Conflict. However, it is important that we celebrate the positive too. In fact, we have a statutory duty to promote and explain



what are defined as the 5 key British Values:

- Democracy.
- The rule of law.
- Individual liberty and mutual respect and tolerance of those with different faiths and beliefs.
- Developing personal and social responsibility.
- Respect for British Institutions

During their time at Edmund Waller, we teach the children about a range of beliefs from the six main faiths - Christianity, Islam, Judaism, Sikhism, Hinduism & Buddhism under our Religious Education curriculum. This is as well as acknowledging a range of differing beliefs from the past to the present.

This week also saw members of our Muslim community celebrating Eid - Happy Eid!
