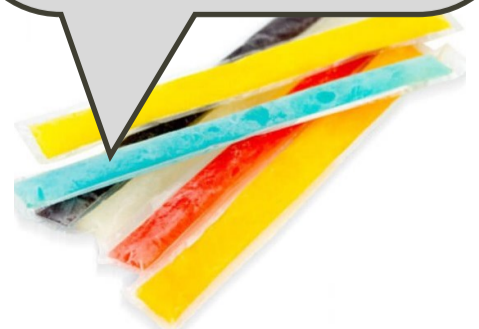
Sports day(s)
