

We are very pleased to be able to announce that a small dedicated band of parents, with children in various phases of the school, have come forward to keep the PTA moving. The inaugural PTA event will be the upcoming Winter Fair, which will take place on Saturday 16th December between 12 - 3pm.

The EW Winter fair has long been a highlight of the PTA's fundraising efforts. Quite rightly, parents often ask what the money is used for. There are some quite strict rules for how the money is spent, for example, funds cannot be used to fund curriculum resources. However, in recent years the PTA have

Supported key events such as the school's concert at the Troxy Theatre
