Science Week 2022: Lab coats - Optional, Learning - Essential



Yesterday, Michelle, our fabulous Nursery & Science Lead, wrote to all parents to announce that next week is Science Week! As a school, we have spent this year identifying our school values and developing our ethos so that it truly reflects the direction of the school and the community we serve. This work has led to the redesign of our humanities curriculum - embedding our key themes (see image) throughout the children's learning.

Next year, we will focus our efforts on developing our children's learning in the subjects known as STEM subjects (Science, Technology, Engineering and Maths)
