

MAYA BELIEFS

The Maya believed in lots of gods, but there were five main ones.
 Itzamna: the creator god,
 K'inich Ahau: the sun god,
 Hun hunabpu: the maize/corn god,
 Chaac: the rain god,
 Kukulkan: a feathered serpent god who wanted human sacrifices.
 There were 2 levels, heavens and the underworld. The heavens had 13 levels, while the underworld had 9. If you were a priest, died in war or got sacrificed you would get to go to the heavens. If you died of natural causes you would go to the underworld.

MAYA DAILY LIFE

The Maya people lived in parts of central America which back then was called Mesoamerica. They made their houses out of wood, mud, stone, and often had a thatched roof. Their main diet includes: maize, beans, squash and chilli peppers.

The Maya were the first to think of the idea 'zero' and they used hieroglyphs to write.
