





As part of our work with Citizens UK we are part of an alliance of Lewisham primary schools, who



We then took to the streets, marching to Lewisham Town Hall to deliver an open letter to Lewisham council, signed by the heads, church leaders and GPs, testifying to the impact of poor quality housing on the education of its youngest citizens. The children felt empowered by the march,

which included; drumming, cheers and honks of support from passing motorists!! The letter was accepted by the head of Lewisham housing and we will keep the pressure up to ensure a positive outcome. We will keep the community posted!
