Mrs Ehsani loves singing, drawing and any baking or cooking activities.







Our closest gate is the entrance on Walsham road. We open the gate at 8:50am – 9:00am.


Home time is at 3.30

We are so lucky to have a sensory pod that we use everyday, for group relaxation sessions and individual play.


