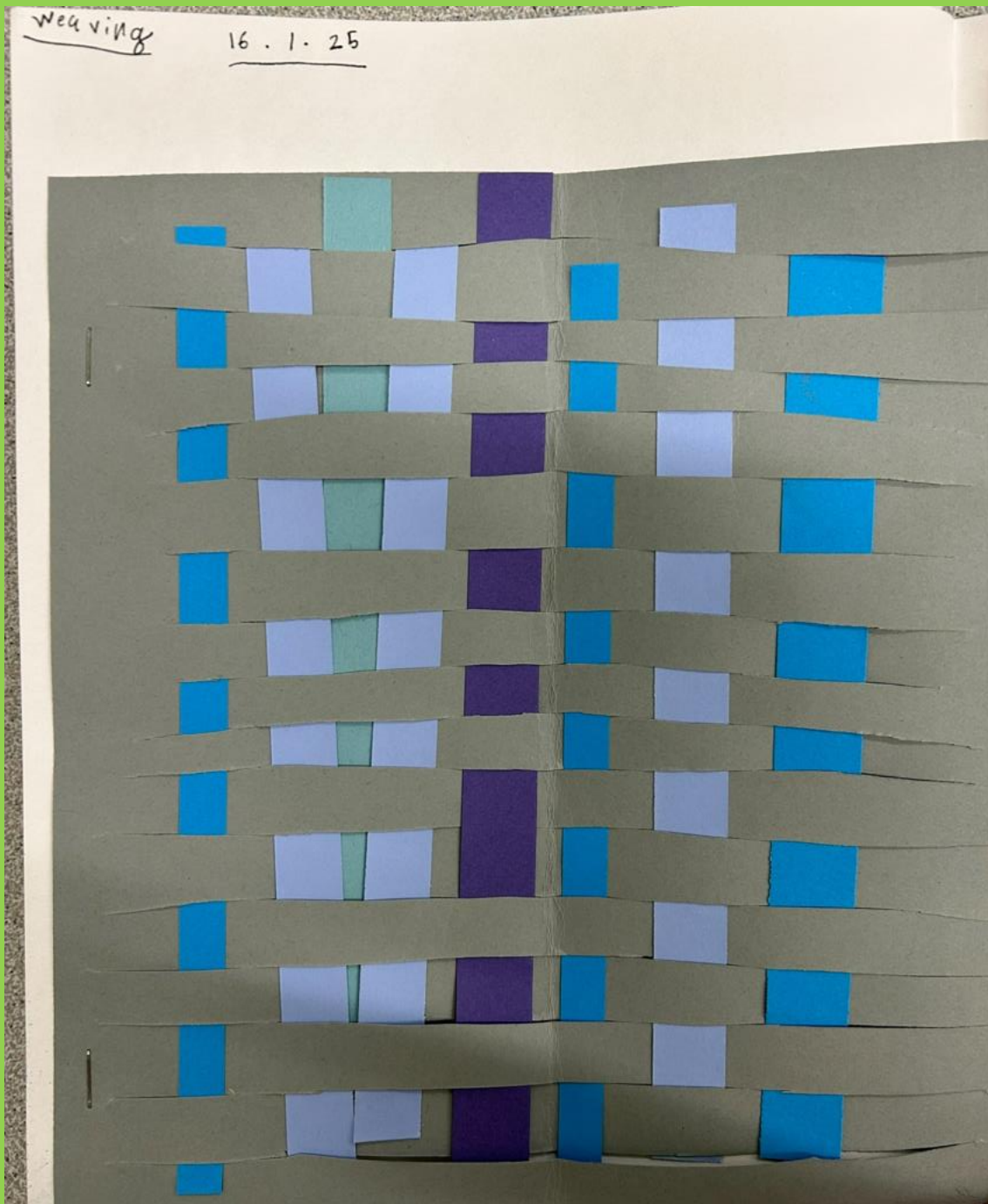
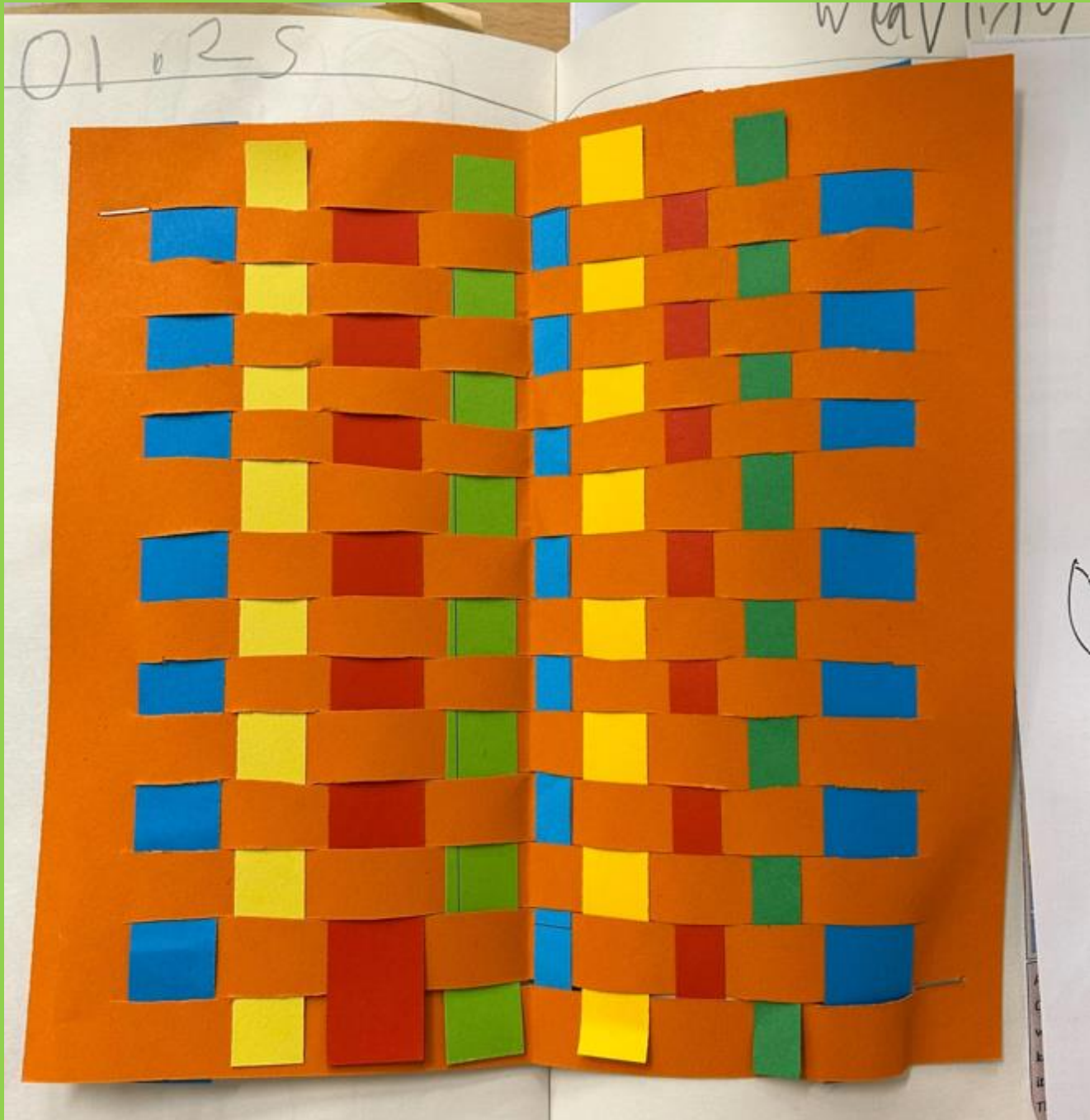

The Kingdom of Benin became bigger.

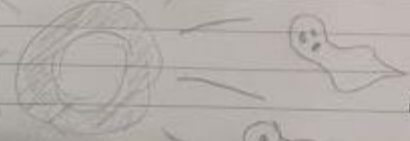
1470 CE portugese traders came over and traded with the Benin Kingdom and got lots of weapons to help their Kingdom grow. This is when Benin was at its highest point.

1540CE Benin had a trading agreement with portugal to give them silver bracelets that were said to keep away spirits.

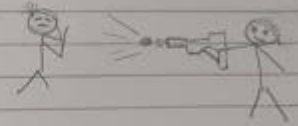


Benin became a trading hub and a bunch of other country's kept coming to trade.



1600s

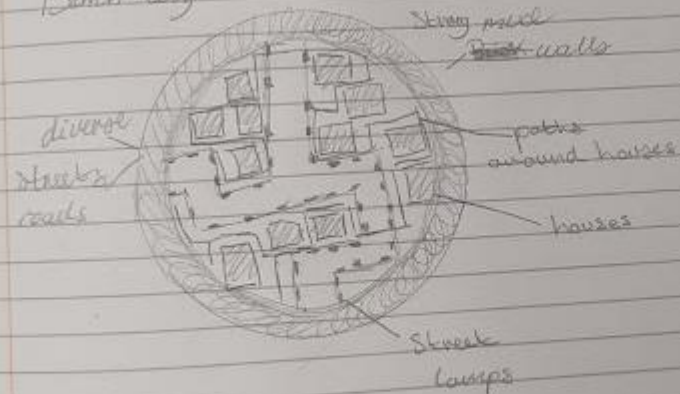
At first, guns were not traded. But after time, they started trading them. The Benin Kingdom started using guns but only had a few. Then the british army had more guns and invaded the Benin.
