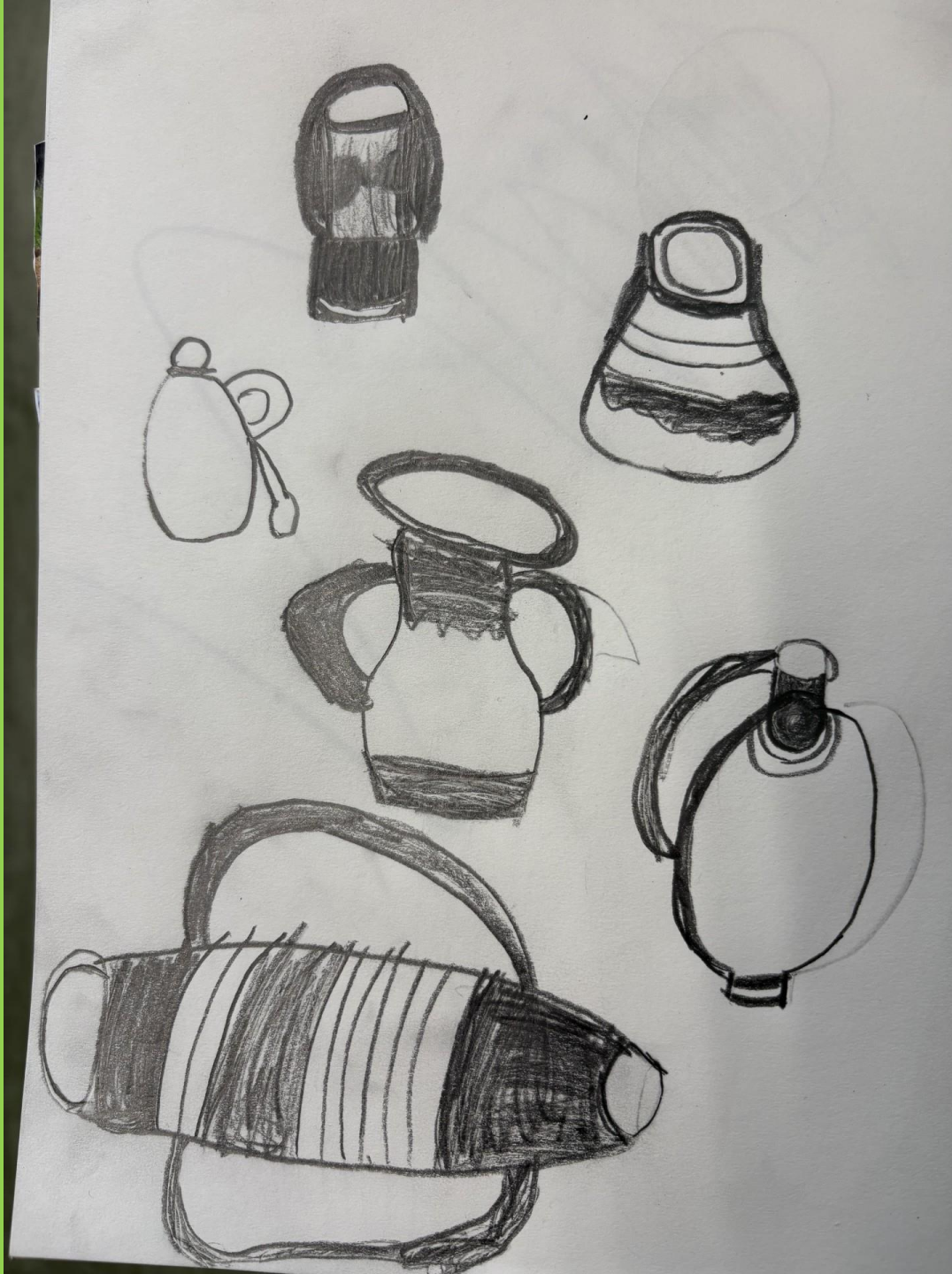

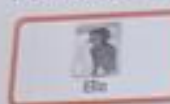

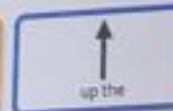

How does the key feel in Ella's hand?



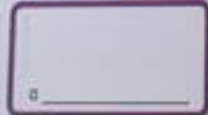
2. Improve the 'describe' and 'where' to complete the sentence.
