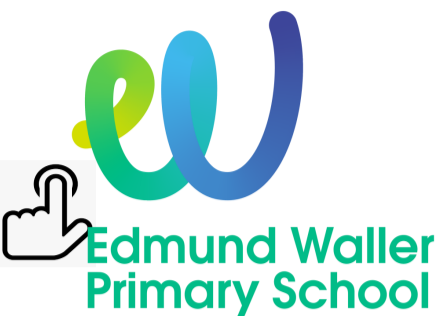

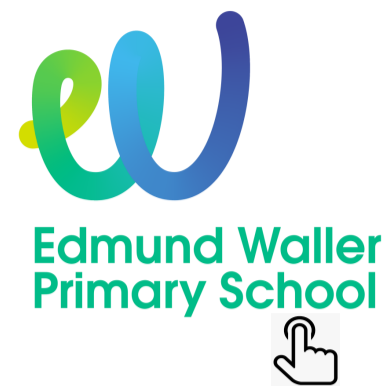

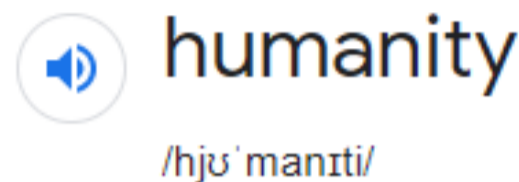


# Edmund Waller WEEKLY NEWSLETTER
