The Sun

Stars are orbited by planets which can be orbited by moons. The sun is one of billions of stars. It is 130,000 times bigger than earth. Without the sun, life on Earth wouldn't be possible. It is over 4.5 billion years old. Never look directly at the sun because it can damage your eyes.

Earth's orbit

Earth rotates on its axis. It does a full rotation once every 24 hours. Earth rotates but it is orbiting the sun at the same time. It takes 365.25 days to do a full rotation of the sun. Daytime occurs for the side that is facing the sun while on the other side it is night.

The Moon

The moon spins on its axis. While it spins on its axis it also orbits the earth. At various times in a month the moon appears to be different shapes. This is because as the moon orbits earth, the sun lights up different parts of it.
