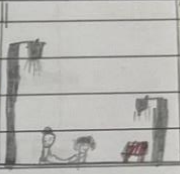
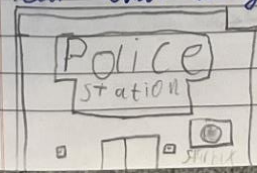

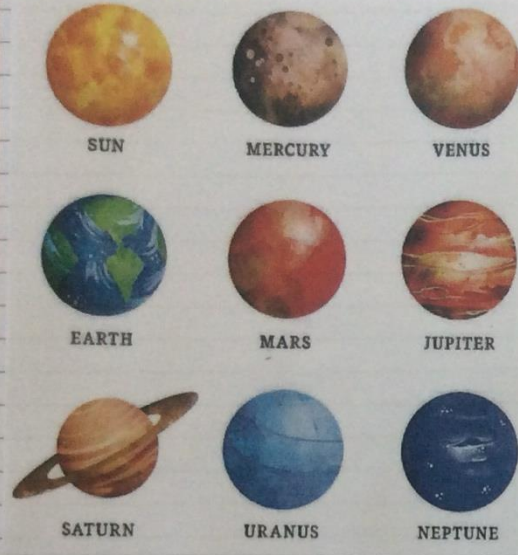

Gas planet facts

- All of the gas planets have many moons.
- They are the furthest planets from the sun.
- They are all much bigger than rocky planets.
- Saturn has 274 moons.
- Jupiter's storm has been going on for millions of years but is starting to stop!

The sun

- In the centre of the solar system is the sun, our star. It is a huge ball of gas made mostly of hydrogen.
- The sun makes up 99% of all the mass in our solar system.
- Astronomers think the sun is about 4.6 billion years old!
- Astronomers also think the sun is about half way through its life time.
- It has 330,000 times more mass than planet Earth.

Moons

- The biggest moon in our solar system is called GANYMEDE from Jupiter it is 5,262 km long.

- dwarf planet - smaller than the solar system's eight planets. (Pluto was part of solar system)

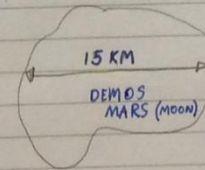

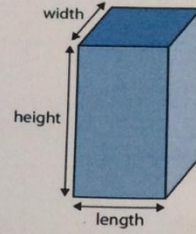
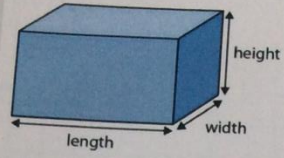
- Mars moon Phobos has a declining orbit. This means that it will be torn apart by gravity in 10 million years time.

Mars's moons are tiny!

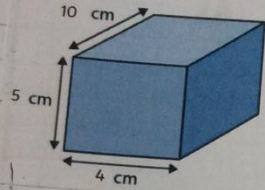

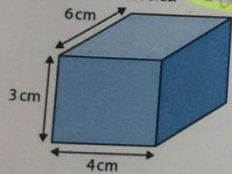

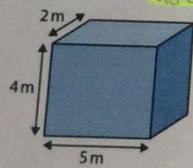

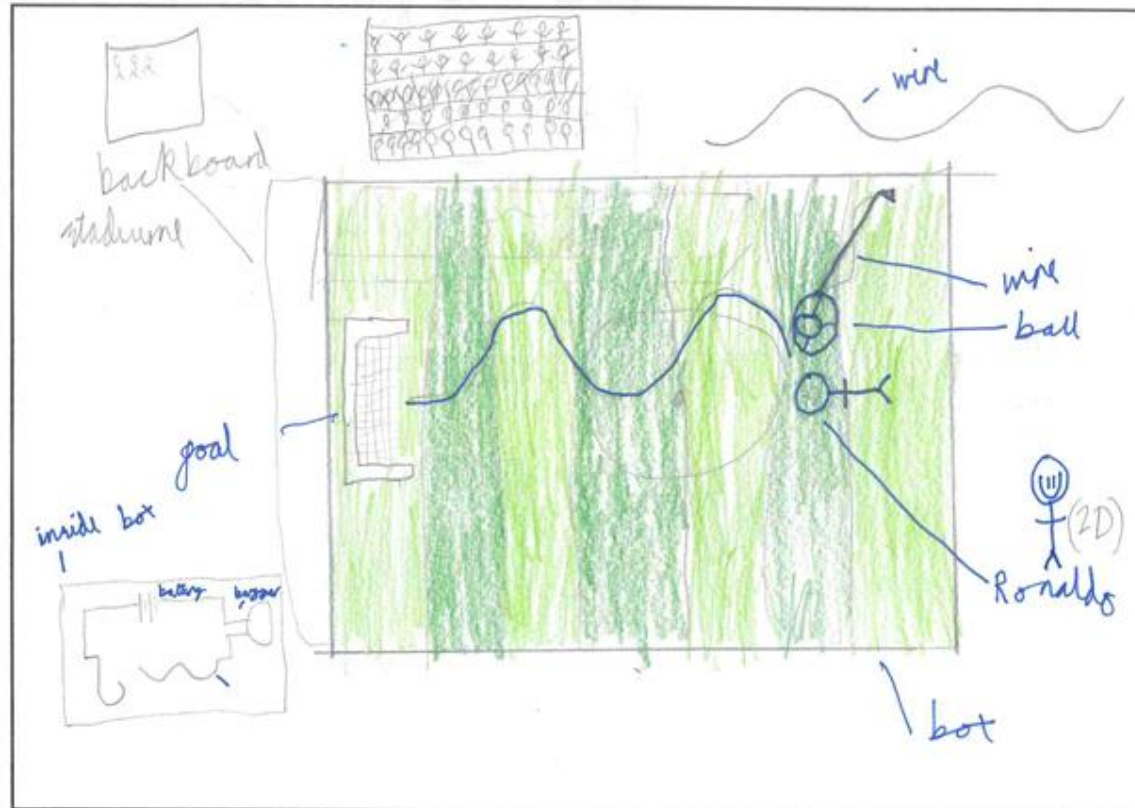

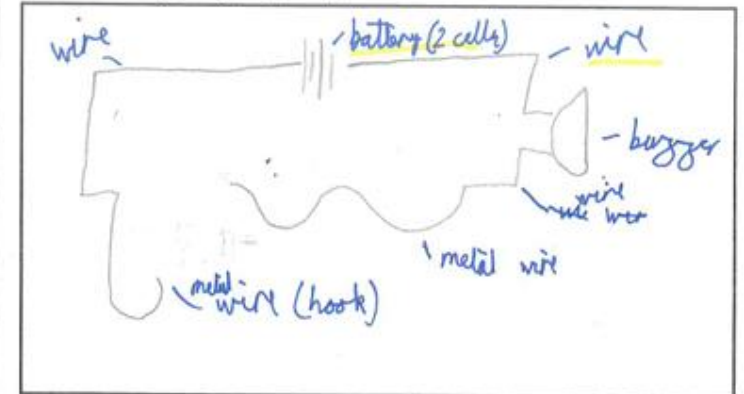
