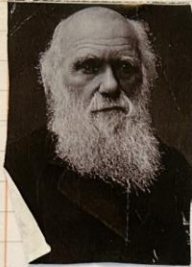

in 1882.



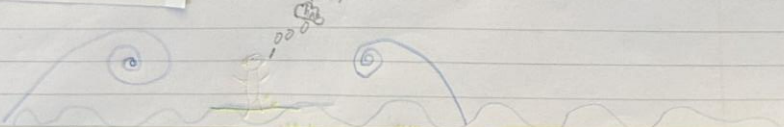
Jane was born in London in 1934
