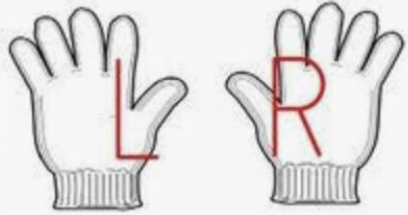


# We Love Adventures! Knowledge Organiser

Hold your hands up palms away.



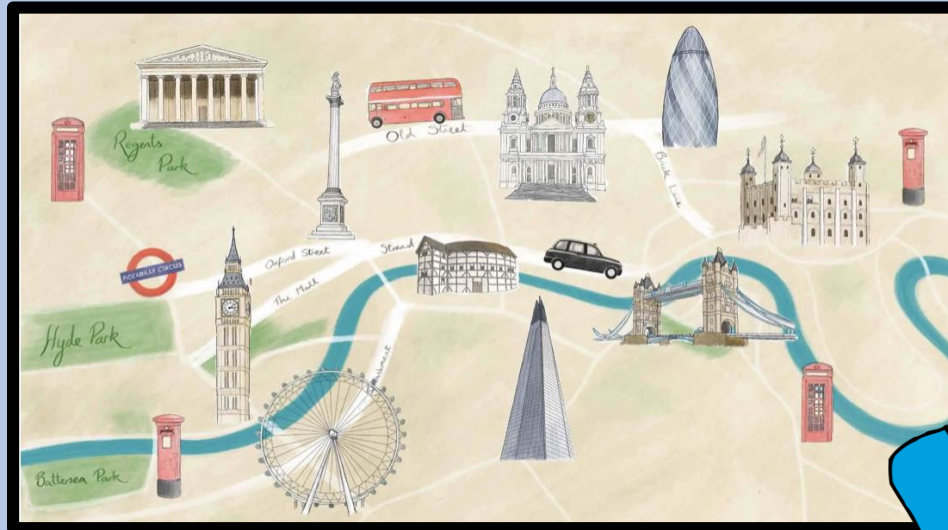

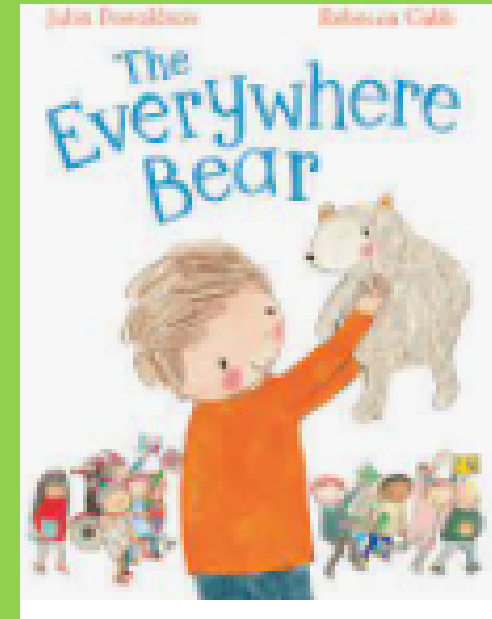

# Exploring doubles

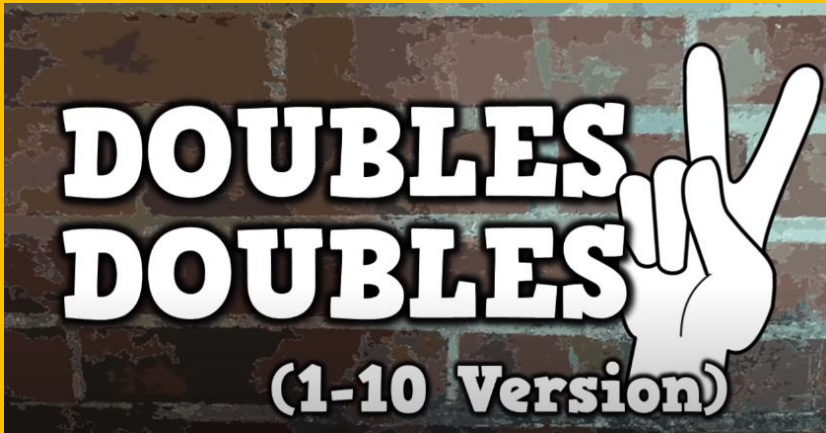
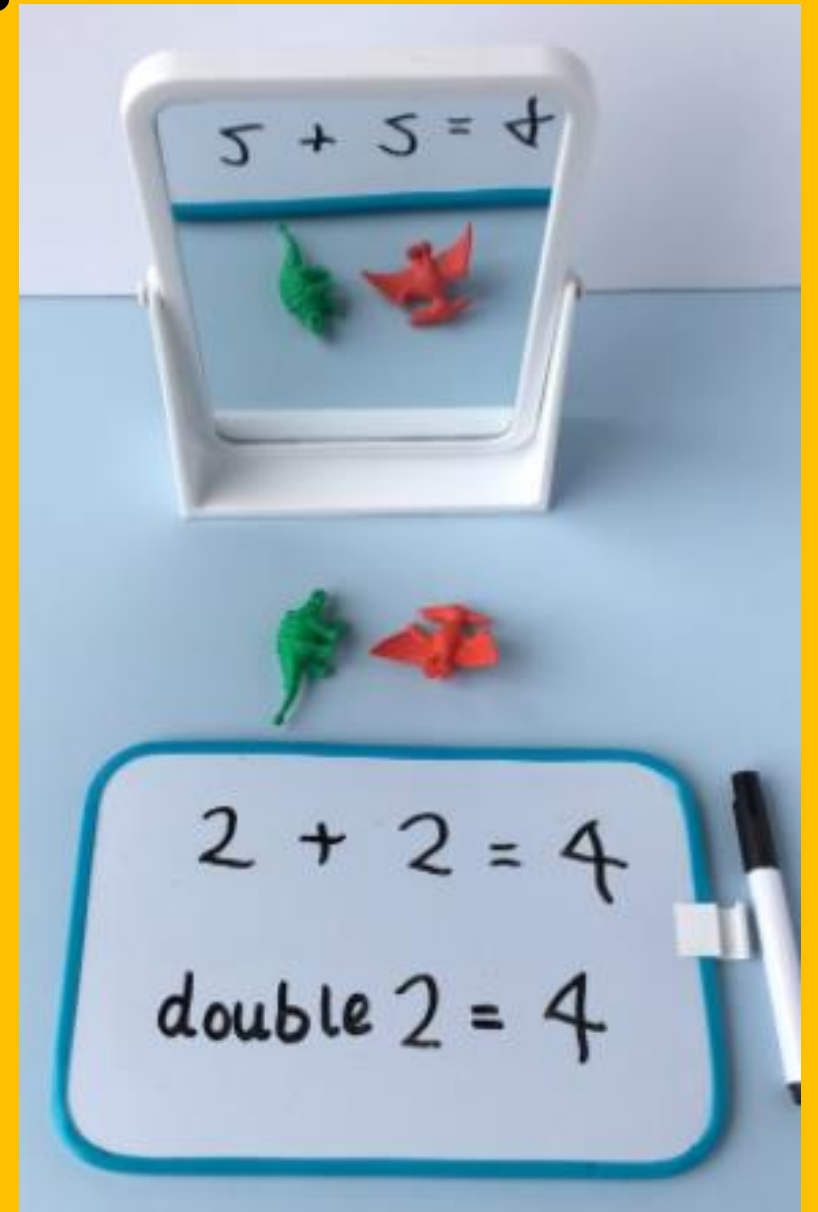
Using objects in your house, explore finding doubles.
