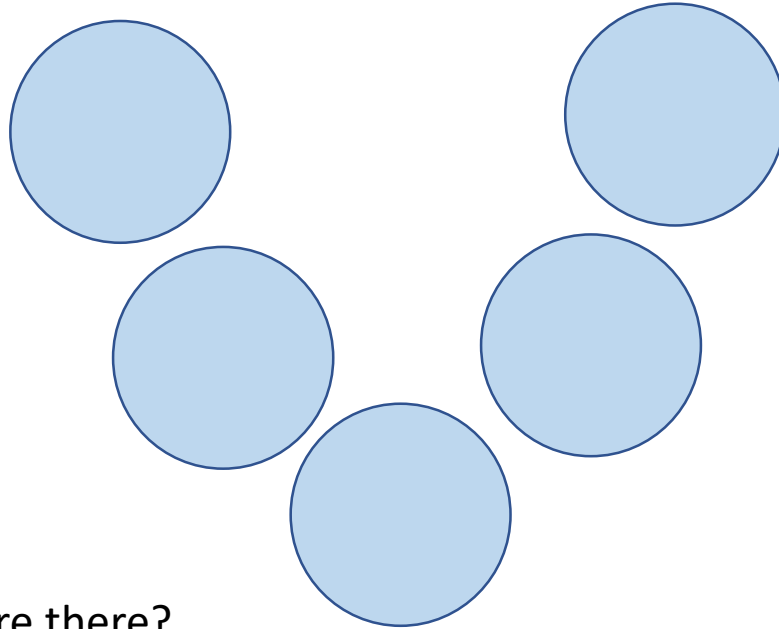




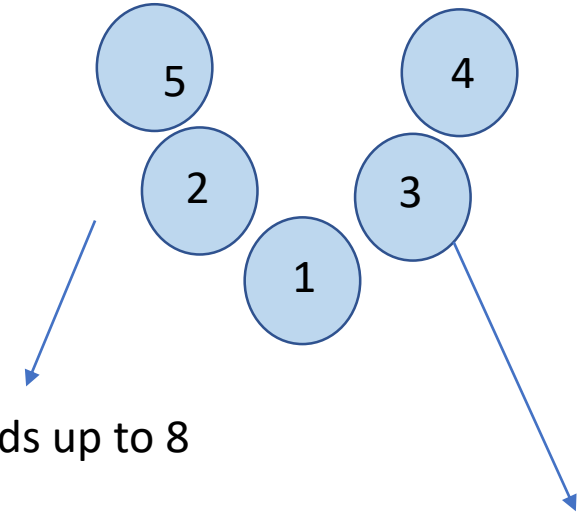

**beginning and end** Do you have speech marks at the **start** and at the **end** of the words being spoken?  
"Action!" said the director.

**new speaker, new line** Have you started a **new line** every time someone new starts speaking?  
"Can we have a close up?" asked Sarah.  
"No problem!" replied Thomas.

**capital letter** Do you have a **capital letter** at the start of the speech?  
Bruce said, "Sorry, I forgot my lines."

**commas** Have you remembered to add **commas**?  
Paul whispered, "Great job."  
"Thank you," replied Justine.

**punctuation** Do you have **punctuation** inside the speech marks?  
"That's a wrap!" cheered the producer.

**different names** **Inverted commas**  
**Quotation marks**  
**Speech marks**  
There are 3 names for this piece of punctuation.
