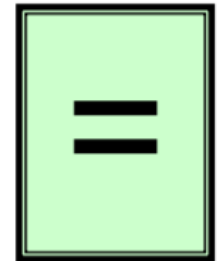
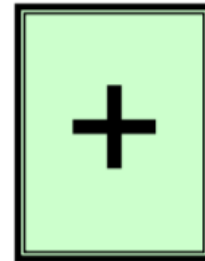
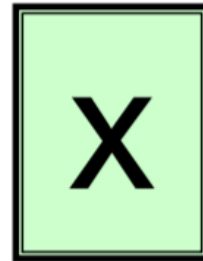
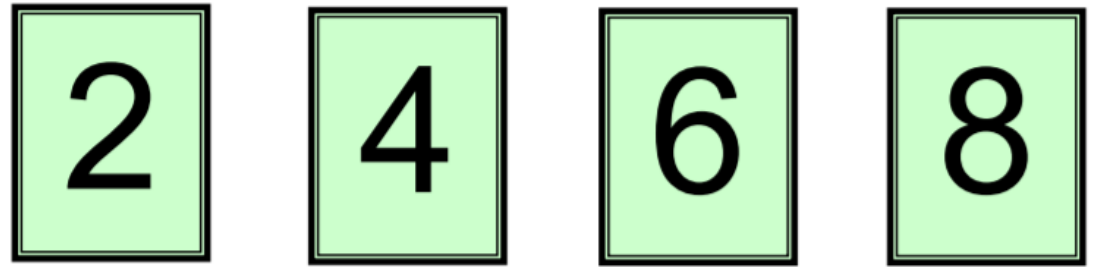


Start anywhere and collect five numbers by following the paths - no jumping or going back over a path twice!
