

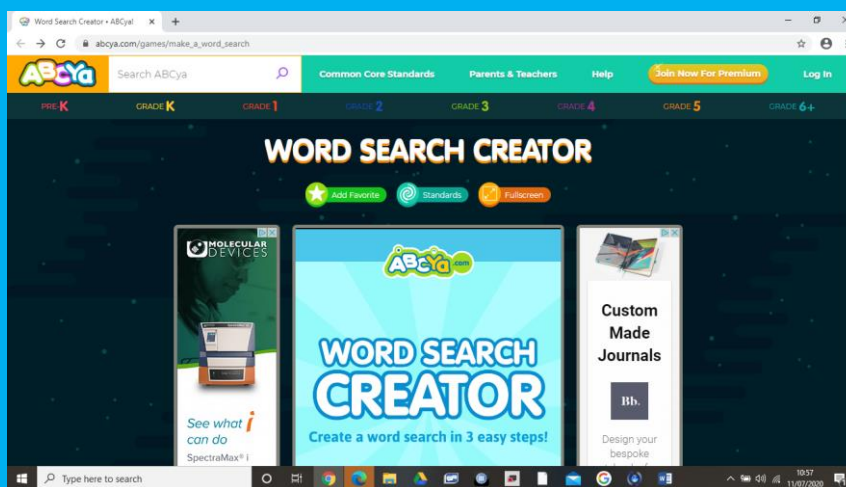
Please remember to read for a minimum of half an hour every day and spend at least 15 minutes on Doodle Maths.

Try these for a challenge!

If

$$A + C = A$$

$$F \times D = F$$

$$B - G = G$$

$$A + H = E$$

$$B/H = G$$

$$E - G = F$$

and $A-H$ represent the numbers from 0 to 7

Find the values of A, B, C, D, E, F, G and H .

you have a perfect square.

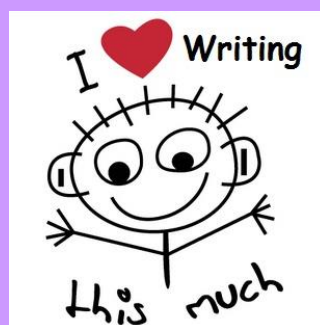
Or you can reverse and subtract, and
